



## Annual Admission Notice 2022/2023

The following Annual Admission Notice has been prepared by the board of Coláiste Chiaráin in respect of the admission of students to the school for the school year 2022/2023. This notice was published on 27/09/2021.

All applications to the First Year Group or the Special Class (for ALL year groups) in Coláiste Chiaráin will only be accepted after 04/10/2021 and the closing date for receipt of applications is 10/01/2022 at 12:30 p.m. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.



All transfer applications to the Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth or Sixth Year Groups in Coláiste Chiaráin other than to the Special Class, will only be accepted after the 04/10/2021 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 04/11/2021. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore, if a student is seeking a place in the Special Class and is not successful in a given academic year or is on a waiting list for this year, a new application must be made for the following year.
