### **Apprenticeship Culinary Taster Course**

TY students had the opportunity to partake in a "Apprentice Culinary Taster Course" in partnership with the Limerick & Clare ETB Further Education & Training Hub. This is a wonderful opportunity for students as they get to experience group cookery classes with professional chefs such as Mr. Tom Flavin. The programme runs every Wednesday from 9am to 1pm throughout the year in six week blocks.

The classes consist of 12 students which are led by Chef Tom. Students get to witness and experience a professional skill set such as his, as well as develop their own skills each week. Students will make an array of dishes during the programme such as homemade granola, smoothies, spicy chicken burgers, curry and parsnip soup, sticky toffee pudding, chocolate chip cookies and brownies to name a few.

This course endeavours to provide students with the necessary materials and mentorship to explore their potential culinary talents and the possibility of cheffing as a career path. It also enables students to build confidence in the kitchen and enter competitions at a regional level throughout the year.




## Coláiste Chiaráin First Year Wellbeing Talks

2nd and 3rd year language students created bookmarks. They used the key question words by following the 5 Ws and 1H format, linking words and classroom language when designing their bookmarks.


2nd year European Studies students designed posters to promote the day.
